New IRB requirement for student researchers

Starting **Aug. 15**, the Institutional Review Board (IRB) will require students conducting research with human subjects to take a one-time, online training – in addition to CITI training – before submitting their first IRB application.

Michele Kennett, associate vice chancellor for research compliance and integrity, is working with University of Missouri-Kansas City to establish and run one of five NSF-backed regional centers charged with safeguarding the U.S. research enterprise.

The Office of Human Research Protections, Department of Health and Human Services, is offering a pre-recorded, 95minute <u>Participant-Centered Informed Consent Training</u> for those who plan, write or review consent forms for research involving human subjects.
