From athlete to scientist

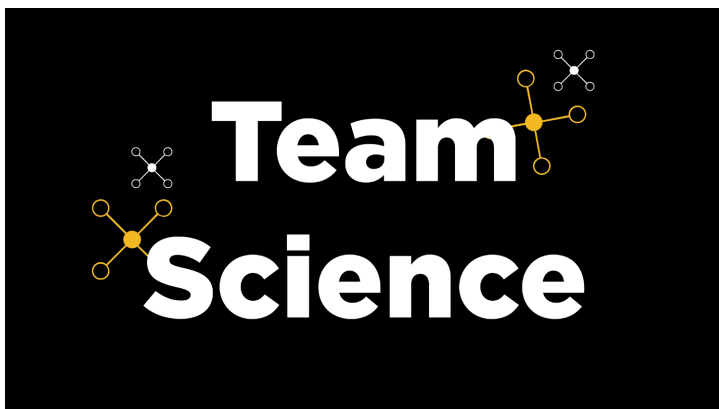
